CONDITIONS OF DINGHY PARK ALLOCATION AND USE

1. Boat parking is for members only. Current membership subscription must be paid either before or with this application.
2. Allocation will be made in strict order of receipt of application. A receipt will be issued on payment but dinghy park stick-on numbers will not be issued until the start of the season.
3. No dinghies are allowed on the dinghy park without prior application in writing and payment.
4. No dinghies are allowed on the dinghy park before the first weekend of the new racing season.
5. All dinghies must use the space allocated and must be tied down to the anchorage points provided.
6. B.S.C. General committee reserve the right to reposition and make safe any boat on the dinghy park.
7. All road trailers must be removed from the dinghy park. However for 2010 a limited number of Cat Trailer parking spaces will be provided (Four). These four places are on a first come basis and will cost £40 per space. People interested should contact John Bines at the Sailing Club. Please note that dinghy road trailers if not removed from the boat park must be left under their boat when not sailing. If this rule is not adhered to the trailer will be secured and a fee of £20 will be charged to release it. (This charge will go to the Cadet Fund).
8. No cars are allowed in the dinghy park.
9. Dinghies must be removed from the dinghy park and all Club premises by 31 December. If the rule is not adhered to storage fees will be charged.
10. B.S.C. General Committee reserve the right to impound any boat infringing these conditions.
11. B.S.C. shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any property on the dinghy park.

Please note that members allocated boat parking should try to keep their boat space clean of rubbish and the grass cut. To help with this the club has provided waste bins in the boat park areas and a lawn mower to cut the grass. The lawn mower is placed by the race box on most racing days (weather permitting), if it is not there and required please ask a committee member who will make it available.
