BRIGHTLINGSEA SAILING CLUB

We are pleased to say that the Cadet section of the Sailing Club is thriving. While most of the children have parents who are adult members, the Club will accept Cadets or Juniors whose parents are not members provided that it is understood that the Club is not responsible for the actions or behaviour of the children.

All members go afloat from the club at their own risk. However, during Cadet evenings or at weekends when racing or other activities are taking place, safety boats are on the water to provide assistance when required. The Club rules require that personal buoyancy is worn at all times during sailing and this should be provided by the individual. The Club does have a small number of items which may be borrowed on a temporary basis.

On Cadet evenings instruction is provided on a voluntary basis by adult members, but with up to 30 boats on the water it is not possible to give individual attention to each boat or child at all times.

If your child wishes to join the Sailing Club and you are not a member, the General Committee (who review all applications) will require some assurance that a current adult member will accept responsibility. In seeking a proposer and seconder for your child you should find an adult member who would be prepared to be responsible for your child while at the Club.
